## Venue

The 15<sup>th</sup> Symposium of the Young Physiologists will take place at the Campus Mitte of the Charité – Universitätsmedizin Berlin. Oral presentations will be held in the **Oskar-Hertwig lecture hall** while the adjacent **Wilhelm-Waldeyer-Building** will host room for breaks, poster presentations and workshops.

These historic buildings are part of the Institutes of Anatomy and are embedded within a larger green space.



## Exhibition

The exhibition is scheduled for April 9 and 10 of the symposium in the **Wilhelm-Waldeyer-Building** during coffee breaks, poster sessions and workshop / industry presentation session. The exhibition area is positioned centrally and will host the poster exhibition as well as the catering area.

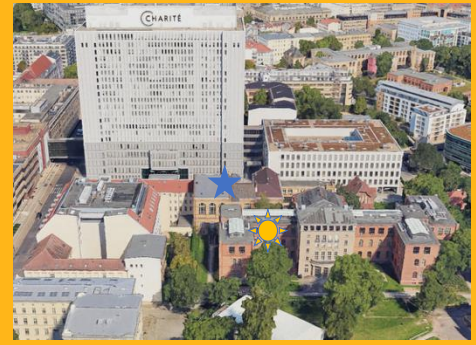
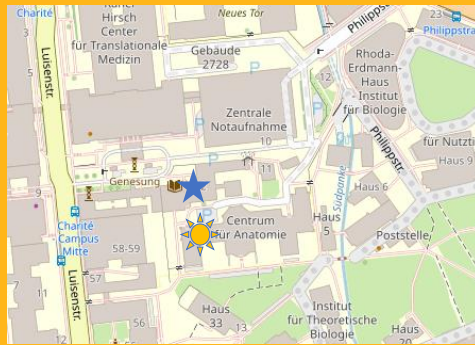

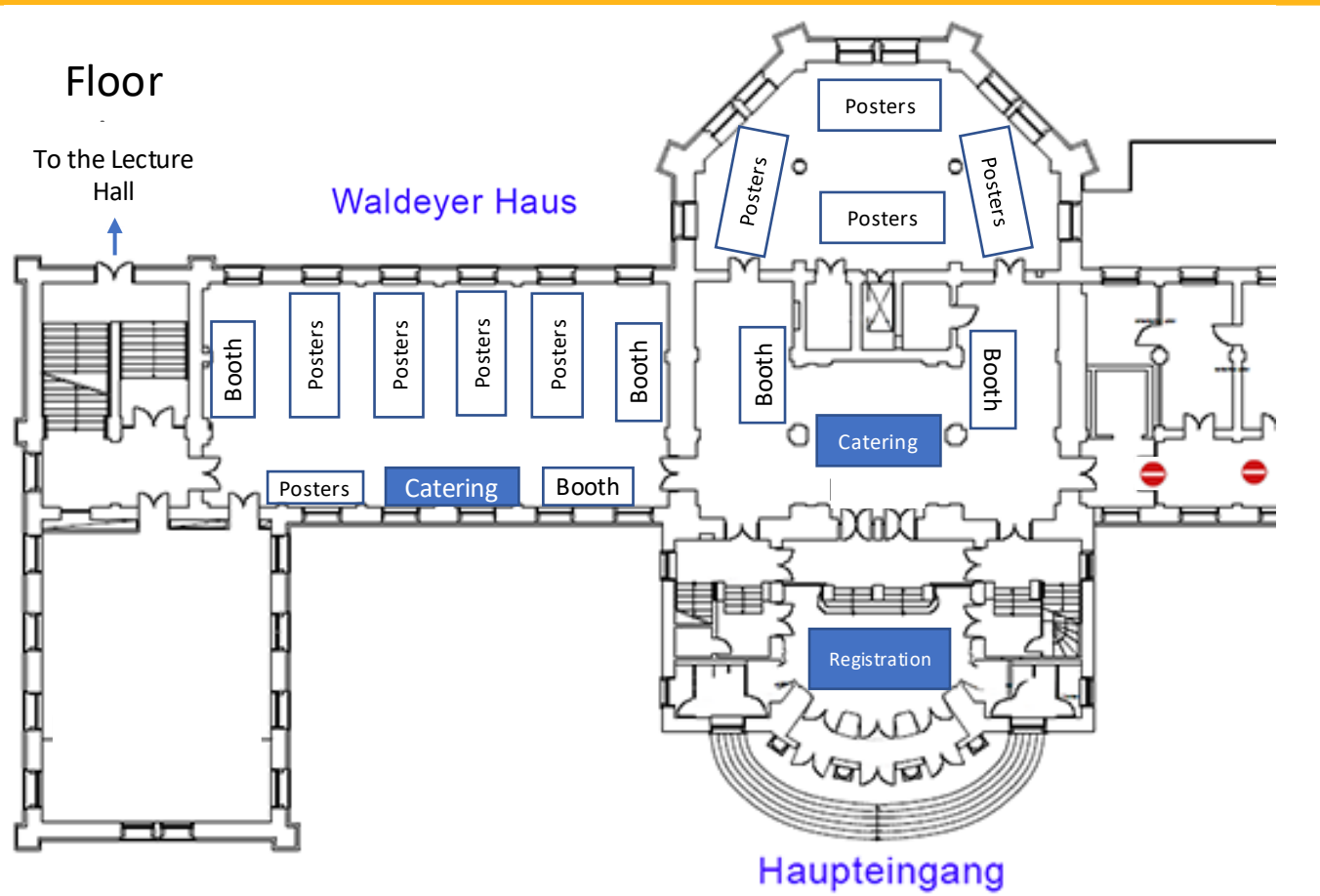
